## **Assessment At DU**



Assessment is primarily the ongoing systematic process of understanding and improving teaching and learning.



## **Assessment At DU**



#### Higher Learning Commission (HLC) Criterion 4

- "The institution demonstrates responsibility for the quality of its educational programs, learning environments and support services, and it evaluates their effectiveness for student learning through processes designed to promote continuous improvement."
- **4.B.** The institution engages in ongoing assessment of student learning as part of its commitment to the educational outcomes of its students.
- 1. The institution has effective processes for assessment of student learning and for achievement of learning goals in academic and cocurricular offerings.
- 2. The institution uses the information gained from assessment to improve student learning.
- 3. The institution's processes and methodologies to assess student learning reflect good practice, including the substantial participation of faculty, instructional and other relevant staff members.



## **Assessment At DU**



- Meaningful assessment helps answer your important questions about teaching and learning
- It has transparent, clear, concise, and measurable outcomes
- It uses aligned direct and indirect measures
- It has clear supporting data and a contextualized narrative
- It involves students, faculty, and staff in the feedback process



## The Assessment Cycle at DU

#### **April-June**

Faculty work together to complete and submit the Annual Assessment Report.

### **July-August**


Feedback from Academic Leaders completed.

#### **September**

Return of reports with feedback for discernment.

## **September-March**

Dialogue, Implement plan, Collect Data, Reflect for next report

- How did previous assessment work influence teaching and learning in program?
